## NCHN Membership Application Process

NCHN annual dues are based on the networks operating budget. Current dues are as follows:

- Less than \$250,000 — \$500
- \$250,000—\$500,000 — \$750
- Over \$500,000 — \$1,000

Membership applications are accepted at any time and dues are prorated.

\*Operating budget is defined as revenue allocated for the operations of a member organization. "Flow through" accounts (accounts that do not add to the actual income/expenses of the member organization) should not be considered in determining NCHN dues.

Networks interested in NCHN membership should complete the on-line application form. Individuals interested in joining NCHN must call the NCHN office.

The NCHN Board of Directors approves all membership applications. The application process takes 3-7 days.
